Statement:

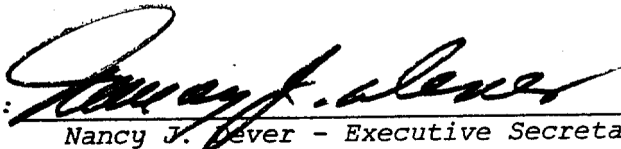
