Parties to Dispute: (Dort D. Howery  
(Burlington Northern Railroad Company

Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Burlington Northern Railway Company violated the terms of Agreement, when they arbitrarily removed Dort Howery's name from the Minot-Yellowstone District Seniority Roster and refused to allow him to exercise his seniority on a permanent labor position at Glendive, Montana.
2. That, accordingly, the Burlington Northern Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Dort D. Howery in the amount of eight (8) hours pay for his rate and class for each work day commencing January 26, 1984 and continuing until properly assigned.
3. Further, that Dort D. Howery's name be placed in its proper order on Minot-Yellowstone District Roster, and that he be made whole for any other benefits he would have amassed during the period of time he was denied employment.

Statement:


