**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** That Mr. R. O. White be paid at the foreman's rate, one (1) hour daily and three and one-half (3½) hours on Sundays, when he is taking the place of foreman. The daily differential to be paid from September 15, 1936; the Sunday differential from May 15, 1938.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
