**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:** That Thomas Maddock, with seniority date of April 12, 1926, in the Maintenance of Way and Structures Department, be compensated for all time lost between February 1 and March 7, 1938, as a result of being furloughed and his work transferred to the Maintenance of Equipment Department; total wage loss \$218.40.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
