**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:** That Labor Gang Foreman J. C. Zweig be removed from and be stopped performing carmen's work as defined in Rule 86-1, and in violation of Rule 33, and that car inspectors who were laid off on account of labor gang foreman performing their work be paid for all time labor gang foreman has displaced them.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
