**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** That furloughed Carman F. C. Curtis be compensated for time lost covering period June 8 to June 9, 1939, inclusive, account of Maintenance of Way Carpenter C. Deal being assigned to build dump beds for hand cars, in violation of Rule 149, Car-men's Classification of Work.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
