**INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS  
RAILWAY EMPLOYES' DEPARTMENT, A. F. OF L.**

**RAILWAY EXPRESS AGENCY, INCORPORATED**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:** (1) That Machinist J. F. Handley be compensated in line with Mediation Agreement from September 1 to November 30, 1941, both inclusive, by 7½¢ per hour in addition to his regular rate.

(2) That Machinist J. F. Handley be compensated in line with Mediation Agreement in the amount of \$18.70 per month in addition to his monthly rate retroactive to December 1, 1941.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
