PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 16, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. OF L. (MACHINISTS)**

NORFOLK AND WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

- (1) That under the controlling agreement and particularly Rule 54, the removal, inspection, adjusting, repairing and installing lubricators is machinists' work.
- (2) That the carrier is violating the controlling agreement and particularly Rule 31, when machinists' helpers are assigned to perform the aforesaid work.
- (3) That the carrier be ordered to discontinue the assignment of machinists' helpers to perform the lubricator work herein referred to.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
