**ST. LOUIS-SAN FRANCISCO RAILWAY COMPANY
(St. Louis-San Francisco & Texas Railway Company)**

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1. That over eleven (11) years of service rights of Carman L. E. Hoover at Springfield, Missouri, was unjustly revoked within the meaning of the controlling agreement, particularly Rule 35 (a), by the carrier at 4:00 P. M., Saturday, January 27, 1945.

2. That the carrier be ordered to reinstate Carman L. E. Hoover with all service rights unimpaired and compensate him for all time lost retroactive to 4:00 P. M., January 27, 1945.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
