SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 95, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. OF L. (ELECTRICAL WORKERS)

CHICAGO, BURLINGTON AND QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: That the carrier violated the current agreement, particularly Rule 2, thereof, in refusing to assign senior qualified electrician to position of leading electrician.

That B. D. Jones be compensated the difference in monthly rate since junior man was assigned to position on February 9, 1943.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
