**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** That Machinist Joseph Barger is entitled to be compensated from 3 P. M. to 11 P. M., Sunday, July 23, 1944, at the time and one-half rate, and from 11 P. M., July 23 to 7 A. M., July 24, 1944 at the double time rate, for services which he had a contractual right to perform on Turbine No. 2, at the Bluestone Power House.
