AMERICAN REFRIGERATOR TRANSIT COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: That it is improper under the current agreement to assign carmen helpers to operate punches and shears in the preparation of material to be used in building and making repairs to cars and, accordingly, the carrier be ordered to discontinue the assignment of carmen helpers to perform such work.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
