**CHICAGO, INDIANAPOLIS AND LOUISVILLE
RAILWAY COMPANY**

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1—That under the current agreement it was improper to assign employes of the Vapor Car Heating Company, Inc., to perform machinists' work in the amount of 1½ hours on Diesel Engine No. 84 between 12 Noon and 2:30 P. M. on November 29, 1947.

2—That accordingly the carrier be ordered to additionally compensate Machinist C. J. Murphy in the amount of 5 hours call pay for this work on the date aforesaid.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the parties that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
