UNION TERMINAL COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: a) That under the current agreement the Chief Power Plant Electrician and the two Power Plant Electricians have been improperly paid since September 1, 1949.

b) That accordingly the carrier be ordered to establish the proper monthly rate for these positions and compensate the incumbents of these positions the difference between what they have received and what they should have received retroactive to the aforesaid date.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was not held, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
