**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 42, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'  
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L. (Machinists)**

**ATLANTIC COAST LINE RAILROAD COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** 1. That Machinist Helper R. D. Shiver was deprived of making a road trip on January 13, 1952 contrary to the jointly established custom for the distribution of overtime at Lakeland, Florida, under the current agreement.

2. That, accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to additionally compensate this employe Claimant for the aforesaid road trip in the amount of 20½ hours' service at the time and one-half rate.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
