DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: "1. The Carrier is violating the controlling agreement and Rules 27 and 98 thereof, at their train yard and cooper yard at Buffalo, New York, by assigning a freight house employe to inspect cars for commodity loading, and abolishing the job of the car inspector.

2. The Carrier should be ordered to restore to the carmen the work of inspecting cars for commodity loading."

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
