DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: "1. That under the current agreement Train Yard Inspectors are improperly denied the right to use blue flags and blue lights when inspecting and working on trains at Buffalo, New York and Scranton, Pennsylvania Train Yards.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to enforce the right of these Train Yard Inspectors to use blue flags and blue lights when inspecting and working on trains at the aforementioned locations."

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

Claim dismissed.
