PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 97, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A F. of L. (Electrical Workers)**

GULF, COLORADO AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: "1. That under the current agreement the Carrier on Sunday, September 13, 1953, improperly used supervision to replace and adjust Servo fuel control on Diesel-electric Locomotive Unit No. 19-A, generally recognized as work of the Electrical Workers' craft.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate Electrician J. F. West in the amount of four (4) hours at the time and one-half rate on the above stipulated date for the performance of the aforesaid work."

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

Claim dismissed.
