DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1. That under the provisions of the current Agreement, Machinist A. M. Semon of Chanute, Kansas, has been improperly denied the right to perform work of the Machinists' craft, the work being performed by an Electrician.

2. That as a consequence of the above improper handling, the Carrier be directed to additionally compensate Machinist Semon in the amount of eleven (11) hours pay at the overtime rate.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form and the Division is now in receipt of a request from employes that the case be withdrawn.
