**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 97, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'
DEPARTMENT A. F. of L.-C. I. O. (Electrical Workers)**

ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1. That under the current Agreement, the Carrier erred when they did not assign Electrician, Mr. J. M. Castellano, to inspect the electrical equipment, (Namely the electric motors, generator and the wiring thereto) on cars PFE 44107—43381—74855—8597—43838—8634—44693—8697—60432 and 41255, July 6, 1955.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Electrician, Mr. J. M. Castellano, four (4) hours at his regular hourly rate of pay for this Agreement violation.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
