DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1. That at the Calumet Shop, The Pullman Company is violating the controlling agreement when they fail to bulletin positions to be of more than ten (10) calendar days duration showing the normal duties in accord with Rule 42.

2. That the positions be rebulletined to show the normal duties.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
