FLORIDA EAST COAST RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly refused to properly bulletin and describe duties of jobs when bulletined on April 14, 1954.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to bulletin jobs or vacancies so that they might be identifiable for the purpose of exercising seniority.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing was held thereon, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
