That in accordance with the provisions of the applicable agreement and the provisions of the Selective Act, Oscar F. Guterrez be compensated for all time lost from October 17, 1949 to March 1950. And that in addition to this he be compensated for 5 days vacation denied him in each of the years 1945 and 1946.
