1. That under the current agreement others than Machinists were assigned improperly duties of repairing a set of drop hammer dies, November 3, 1955.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to additionally compensate Machinist J. H. Rexroat the amount he would have earned had he performed this work November 3, 1955.
