1. That under current agreement Ernest Shaw, laborer at Kansas City, Missouri, was deprived of work on Saturday, July 21, 1956.
2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the Claimant for a three (3) hour call in accordance with Rule 4 (c) of the agreement.
