**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 114, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Boilermakers)**

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY (Pacific Lines)

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement Boilermaker Helper H. M. DeRoss was improperly denied 15 days vacation with pay for the year 1957.
2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the claimant in the amount of 15 days vacation pay.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
