DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Electrical Workers)

THE READING COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current Vacation Agreement the Carrier improperly compensated the employees we represent (Operators, Engineers, tc.) working at the Port Richmond Coal Dumper for their vacation periods in the year 1956.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the aforesaid employees the difference between what they were paid while on vacation and what was paid the relief worker filling their assignment during their vacation.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
