**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 150, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'**  
**DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Sheet Metal Workers)**  
**THE CINCINNATI UNION TERMINAL COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Sheet Metal Workers to perform the work of repairing pipes inside of water cooler casing, disconnecting and connecting of pipes, resweating of pipe connections, and removing and replacing 18 gauge sheet metal around cooler frame, on May 17, 1956.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate Sheet Metal Worker R. Hirsch and Sheet Metal Worker Helper L. Rains, each in the amount of eight (8) hours pay at the applicable overtime rate for May 17, 1956.

**FINDINGS:** The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

The parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The Board finds the facts in this case to be substantially the same as in Docket No. 2813, Award No. 2931.

AWARD

Remanded to the parties for further handling on the property.
