SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 126, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Firemen and Oilers)

ATLANTA AND WEST POINT RAILROAD COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement Laborer John Mullins was unjustly dealt with when he was denied the right to fill the job on which he was the senior bidder.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to assign the afore-said laborer to the position on which he was the senior bidder.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
