**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 152, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'  
DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Machinists)**

**THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That the overhauling and maintenance of buses comes within the scope of the current Agreement as Machinists' work.
2. That the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, by unilaterally transferring the repair work on Buses Nos. 89062 and 89115 to the Truck Sales and Service Garage violated the current Agreement.
3. That accordingly the Pennsylvania Railroad Company be ordered to:
  - (a) Desist from unilaterally transferring the repairs to said Buses to outside local garages.
  - (b) Compensate B. B. DeMuth in the amount of two (2) days' pay because of this violation.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employee that the case be withdrawn.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
