CHESAPEAKE AND OHIO RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement Carman Jacob Mathes was unjustly dealt with when he was dismissed from service August 2, 1957.
2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to restore the aforementioned Carman to service and compensate him for all time lost retroactive to August 2, 1957.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
