DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier erred, when they failed to compensate Communications Department Electrical Workers, R. K. Williams, V. L. Wheeler, P. C. Perry, W. T. Hooper, T. A. Wheeler, M. A. Jontra, J. D. Scheve, E. R. Harbord, H. L. Walker, J. E. Bandy and W. D. Hill, one and one-half (1½) hours at their regular straight time rate. Waiting time November 26, 1957.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to pay R. K. Williams, V. L. Wheeler, P. C. Perry, W. T. Hooper, T. A. Wheeler, M. A. Jontra, J. D. Scheve, E. R. Harbord, H. L. Walker, J. E. Bandy and W. D. Hill, one and one-half (1½) hours straight time rate.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
