**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 50, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L.—C. I. O. (Carman)**

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the controlling agreement, the Carrier improperly gave Carman Apprentice R. F. Morris a Carman-Mechanic's seniority date of January 3, 1956.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to remove the name of Carman Apprentice R. F. Morris from the Carman-Mechanics' seniority roster until such time as he has completed four years of apprenticeship.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
