**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:**

(a) That under the controlling Agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Sheet Metal Workers to the assembling and installing a new pneumatic message conveyor system commencing on October 7, 1958.

(b) That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the following members of the Sheet Metal Workers' craft in the amounts as follows:
