PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 25, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES' DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L. - C. I. O. (Machinists)

TERMINAL RAILROAD ASSOCIATION OF ST. LOUIS

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1 — That the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis violated the Agreement of February 4, 1965, when they denied birthday holiday pay to M. A. Gray, Machinist, Thursday, August 5, 1965. Brooklyn, Illinois.

2 — That accordingly, the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis be ordered to compensate Machinist Gray in the amount of eight (8) hours for August 5, 1965, his birthday holiday.

FINDINGS: The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The parties hereto have stipulated and agreed that this claim shall be disposed of by the findings as contained in Award No. 5414 for the reason that this dispute involves the same issue. Accordingly, this claim shall be denied.

AWARD

Claim denied.
