PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 101, RAILWAY EMPLOYES' DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Electrical Workers)

GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:

- 1. That the Great Northern Railway Company violated the Agreement of February 4, 1965, when it refused to pay birthday-holiday pay to Electrician John Durkin in the amount of eight (8) hours at pro rata rate for December 12, 1965.
- 2. That accordingly, the Great Northern Railway Company be ordered to additionally compensate Electrician John Durkin in the amount of eight (8) hours at pro rata rate for December 12, 1965.

FINDINGS: The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The facts, evidence and argument present in this case are substantially the same as those presented in Award No. 5552; therefore, the issue has been disposed of, and no useful purpose would be served by disturbing the precedent now firmly established.

AWARD

Claim denied.
