1. That Electricians W. Bartz, T. Johnson, Jr. and N. Kruger were improperly removed from their bulletined positions and assigned other work, effective May 20, 1970.
2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to:
 - (a) Restore these employes to their former positions.
 - (b) Additionally compensate these employes at the straight time rate of pay while the machinist craft is doing their work, retroactive to May 20, 1970, and continuous until practice is stopped.

Statement:


