Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Carrier violated the controlling Agreement when work belonging to the Carmen's Craft was assigned to the Craft of Machinists at Hayne Shop, Spartanburg, S.C. on June 30, 1972.
2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Carmen W. C. Eubanks and J. B. McDougle, Hayne Shop, Spartanburg, S.C. for eight (8) hours pay per day each at their regular rate of pay for June 30, July 5, 6, 7 and 10, 1972. Also eight (8) hours pay each at the straight time rate for Carmen R. L. Godwin and H. M. Frazier for July 3, 1972.
