Dispute: Claim of Employes:

- That the Carrier's use of other than Carmen (outside contractor) 1. to tie down wrecked cars at Rodessa, La. and Mooringsport, La., March 15, 1974 was improper under the controlling agreement.
- That, accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate the 2. following seven (7) Carmen employed at Deramus, Yard, Shreveport. La., eight and one-half $(8\frac{1}{2})$ hours each at time and one-half rate:

R. P. Tyler

G. Lazarus

Findings:

The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

Except for the time and location this dispute is not materially different to the one covered in Award No. 7157. For the reasons stated in that Award the Claim is denied.
