Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That on Wednesday, October 17, 1973, the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis, Missouri violated the Controlling Agreement, particularly Rule 26, when Carrier supervisor dispatched a Brooklyn Shop Electrician, Otto Hofele, to make the Federal field inspection on Unit 559 at Madison Pit, Illinois, in lieu of calling and using an electrician from the Bremen Avenue-14th Street Shop seniority point.

2. That, accordingly, the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis be ordered to compensate (Bremen Avenue - 14th Street) Electrician B. R. Odom four hours' pay, at time and one-half, for this October 17, 1973 violation; and,

3. That, in addition thereto, Carrier be further ordered to pay to the Claimant, an accrued interest on the principal amount claimed, computed at 6% per annum and compounded annually from the anniversary date of the claim.

Findings:

The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The Carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The facts contained in this dispute are identical with the facts contained in Award No. 7162 . Therefore, this claim will be denied for the same reasons as contained in Award No. 7162 .
