## Dispute: Claim of Employes:

- 1) That the Burlington Northern Inc. violated the provisions of Rule 98(c) when it assigned Laborer Robert Jodl to perform carmen helpers' work on cabooses at Northtown Caboose Track, Minneapolis, Minnesota.
- That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the following 2) named carmen helpers eight (8) hours each at the time and one-half rate on each date shown following the claimants' name:

## Findings:

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.
