1. Carrier violated the controlling agreement January 17, 21 and 23, 1975 when they refused to pay Machinist N. F. White the difference between the Machinist rate and the Foreman's rate as provided for in Rules 29, 11 and Appendices "N" and "O" of the current Agreement.
2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Machinist N. F. White the difference in what he has been paid and what he was entitled to be paid in keeping with provisions of Rules 29, 11 and Appendices "N" and "O" of the current Agreement.

Statement:


