

Parties to Dispute: { System Federation No. 7, Railway Employees'

Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That in violation of the current working agreement, The Burlington Northern Inc., did deliberately order members of another craft and exempt personnel at Havre, Montana to perform Electricians' work as defined in our current working agreement.
2. That, accordingly, The Burlington Northern Inc., be ordered to compensate Claimant's Robert Hamaoka, etc. all, Electricians at The Burlington Northern Inc., Havre, Montana Diesel Facility eight (8) hours compensation at time and one half rate for each day that non-electrical forces of the Carrier, ride the heater cars to and from Havre, Montana. Claim to start on date of December 20, 1976 and continue until adjusted. Copy of compiled list of Claimant's, dates of violations and train numbers, covering dates from December 20, 1976 through February 15, 1977, (attached as Employees Exhibits I and L), beginning again under date of November 6, 1977 and continuing until adjusted.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
