Dispute: Claim of Employes:

- 1. That the Missouri Facific Railroad Company violated the controlling agreement, particularly Rule 120, as amended November 1, 1974, when they arbitrarily assigned wracking work contracted to carmen on the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company to carmen on the Houston Belt and Temminal Railroad Company, February 15, 1976, Settegast Yard, Houston, Texas.
- 2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Carman J. Culley in the amount of four (4) hour call for February 15, 1976, as he was available to perform this work.

Findings:

The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the disputativelyed herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The facts and issues in this dispute are substantially similar to those presented in Award No. 7685. Therefore, in accordance with the findings in Award No. 7685 this claim will be denied.
