Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. Under the current controlling Agreement, Mr. Rubin McGaughy, hostler-helper, Chicago, Illinois, was unfairly dealt with when suspended for a period of 10 days of service from the Burlington Northern Inc., on September 7, 1977 to and including September 16, 1977.
2. That, accordingly, the Burlington Northern Inc., be ordered to compensate Mr. Rubin McGaughy for all time lost (80 hours) at the pro rata rate and any reference to this incident stricken from his record.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
