- 2. Coach Cleaner Albert Reed was erroneously charged with poor attendance which allegedly became excessive when he was absent on December 6, 1977 and was late for work on December 9 and 13, 1977.
- 3. That the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company be ordered to compensate Coach Cleaner Albert Reed for all time lost 45 days) and make him whole for any loss of benefits he may have suffered during the time he was unjustly suspended, as per the provisions of Rule 35.
