- 1. Mechanic-in-charge Gregory Chruschielski was unjustly dismissed from service on December 29, 1977.
- 2. Mechanic-in-charge Gregory Chruschielski was erroneously charged with violation of Rule G of the General Regulations and Safety Rules on December 10, 1977.
- 3. That the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company be ordered to reinstate Mechanic-in-charge Gregory Chruschielski, and compensate him for all time lost at eight (8) hours per day dating from December 10, 1977; plus all benefits which are a condition of employment as per Rule 35; and also 6% interest on all monies to which he is entitled.
