Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. Carman Lincoln Peterson, Altoona, Wisconsin was denied compensation for the period of 12:00 Noon to 12:30 while he was away from home station on emergency road work on January 9 and 11, 1979; the amount of one-half hours pay per day at the straight-time rate.
2. That the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company be ordered to compensate Carman Lincoln Peterson for one-half hours pay at the straight-time rate for January 9 and 11, 1979.

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
