Dispute: Claim of Employees:

2. That the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company be ordered to compensate Carmen W. T. Mooney, D. L. Matysik, and R. E. Kuhn, for one half-hours pay at the straight-time rate, and that the Transportation Company in the future correct its violation of the provisions of Rule 10 of the Joint Agreement, and compensate its employes for meal periods while away from home point on emergency road work.
