K. Langford at North Little Rock, Arkansas the overtime provisions of the Agreement, i.e., two hours (2') at the overtime rate for work performed outside his bulletined hours - 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. - June 20, 1978.
- That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to 2. compensate Communications Maintainer R. K. Langford two hours (2') at the overtime rate for June 20, 1978.
